ORDINANCE NO. O-20-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21 “WATER AND SEWER” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FREMONT TO ADJUST THE “SANITARY SEWER” RATES

THE CITY OF FREMONT ORDAINS:

Chapter 21, Article II, Division 2: Rates, Charges & Bills, Section 21-51 “Charges for Service to Premises Generally; Installation of Meters” is hereby amended and replaced with the following:

Sec. 21-51. Charges for Service to Premises Generally; Installation of Meters

The charges for sewer service for premises connected to the system shall be measured by the quantity of water shown on the water or sewage meters and shall be as follows:

<u>Water meters under 2”</u> – Domestic Standard Domestic, Commercial or Industrial Use:	
Readiness-to-Serve (min. ¼-ly bill based on metered water use up to 4,000 gals. / quarter) ..	20.60
Rate / 1,000 gals. water used per quarter of 5,000 gals. or more / quarter	2.52
 <u>Water meters 2” and over</u> – Commercial or Industrial Use only:	
Readiness-to-Serve (min. ¼-ly bill based on metered water use up to 4,000 gals. / quarter)	132.00
Rate / 1,000 gals. water used per quarter of 5,000 gals. or more / quarter	3.15

All premises connected to the system shall have a water meter or a sewage meter as determined by the City Manager. Such meter shall be furnished and installed in a suitable location by the property owner. (2-10-58, § 8; 12-6-71, § 1; 6-4-73, § 1; 7-18-77, § 1; 9-17-84; Ord. of 6-6-88; Ord. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately on May 18, 2020.
