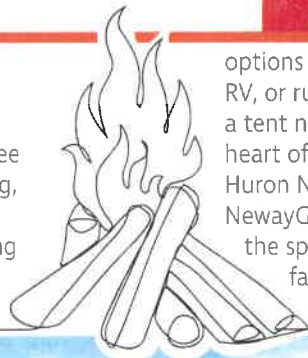
1 Visit a Cider Mill

Fall in Michigan is never complete without a visit to a cider mill. In Newaygo County you will find two treasured fall destinations: **Heritage Farms Market** and **Nelson's Farm Market**. Gather the family and head to the country to sip some cider, pick a pumpkin, and get lost in a corn maze. Whether you are 5 or 85, there is just something about a big red barn, the smell of fresh baked goods, and a meandering hayride that keeps us coming back year after year.



3 Fall Camping

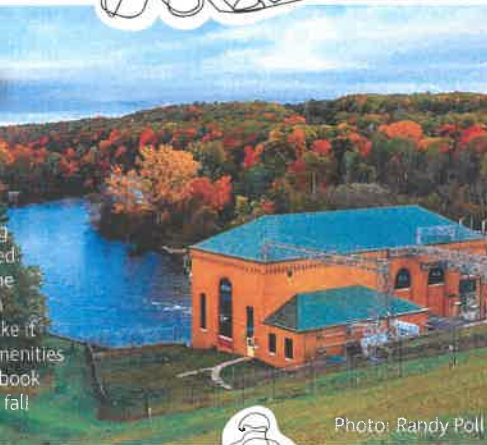

6 Take in the Arts Tour

While on your fall color tour you won't want to miss the public art installations of the Newaygo County's Art Trail. This self-guided tour will show you the way to 25+ public art installations along a simple to navigate route around the county. Enjoy original artist's works from murals to sculpture while you take in the fall colors of the quaint towns of our region. Explore 11 public art displays on a walking tour of Fremont, and then take a ride to enjoy even more historic and creative works of art throughout the county.

7 Fall Color on the Dragon

13+ miles of wooded technical trails invite you to an action-packed color tour biking The Dragon. The initial trail segments include: 7 bridges, 3 scenic overlooks, 100 feet of rock armoring, and 400 feet of wooden boardwalk, creating a trail that is both challenging and fun.



8 Hiking the North Country Trail Welcome Center Loop/40th St Trailhead

The North Country Trail links scenic, natural, historic, and cultural areas across America's northern heartlands and Newaygo County is home to over 50 miles of the NCT. Experience a section hike of this nationally renowned trail at the Newaygo County Welcome Center. This looped trail is about 2 miles long and is the perfect fall color hike that anyone of any experience level can enjoy.

9 Hunting on Public Lands

With fall comes the highly anticipated hunting seasons for white tail deer, small game, and waterfowl. Newaygo County welcomes sportsmen & women to hunt public land throughout the fall season and into winter.

10 ORV/ATV

The Michigan Cross Country Cycle Trail in White Cloud offers over 16 miles to ride in Newaygo County, and connects to other regional trail systems, and don't forget, the roads of Newaygo County are also Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) friendly.
