The requirements for applying for paid-on-call membership within the City of Fremont include:

- Live or work within (5) miles of Fremont Fire Station located at 101 East Main Street
- Be at least 18 years of age and high school graduate, or possess a GED equivalent
- Possess a valid Michigan driver's license
- Complete the application for paid on call membership form
- Capable of performing the job functions
- Communication skills
- Submit to a background check
- Submit to one or more interviews
- Submit to a medical evaluation

**Highly recommend having a conversation with your employer to leave work in order to respond to incidents.*

The requirements for maintaining paid on call membership with the City of Fremont include:

- Complete the Firefighter I & II training academy within the probationary time period.
- Attend monthly meetings/trainings on the first, third, and fourth Mondays of the month.
- Respond to a minimum of 25% of incidents quarterly
- Abide by department policies at all times.
- Note: Firefighting is a physically demanding job. Maintaining a healthy lifestyle and physical fitness is strongly encouraged.
