What: 5K Run/Walk

(Run will have a clock at the finish line but results will not be kept.)

When: Saturday, September 24, 2022

Registration: 8:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.

Run/walk begins: 8:40 a.m. – 8:50 a.m.

Where: Branstrom Park, Fremont, MI

Who: Anyone who is interested in adding more healthy activity to his/her life.

How much: Free

Free T-shirt:

The first 150 applicants who pre-register by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 12, 2022 will receive a free T-shirt provided by the City of Fremont, Koffee Kuppe, The Fremont Recreation Center, The Original Print Shop and Tamarac. You can register the day of the event but there is no guarantee of a free t-shirt, so register early! Ages 7 and older are eligible for a free shirt.

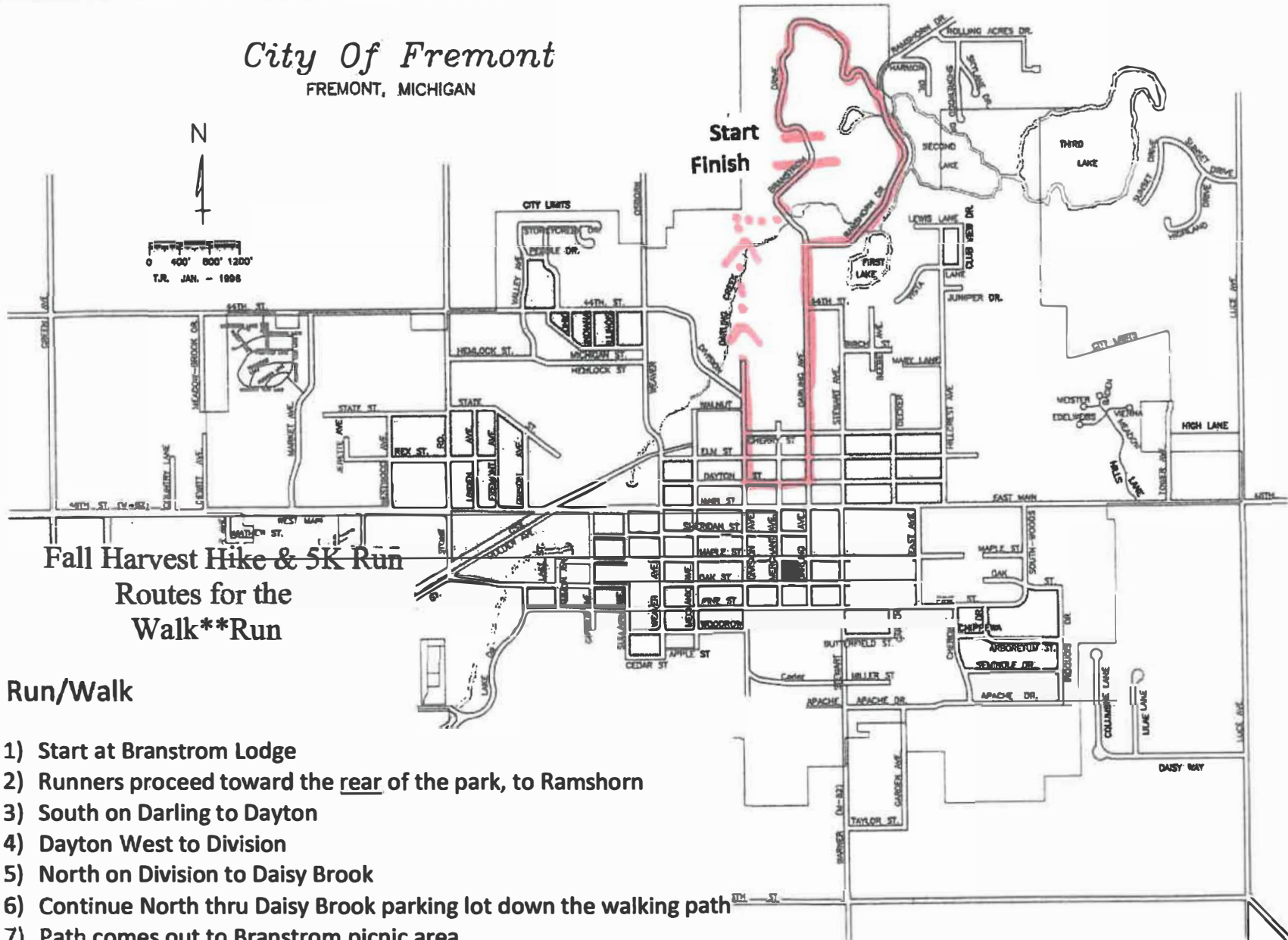

Routes for the
Walk**Run

5K Run/Walk

- 1) Start at Branstrom Lodge
- 2) Runners proceed toward the rear of the park, to Ramshorn
- 3) South on Darling to Dayton
- 4) Dayton West to Division
- 5) North on Division to Daisy Brook
- 6) Continue North thru Daisy Brook parking lot down the walking path
- 7) Path comes out to Branstrom picnic area
- 8) Turn left up hill and end at Lodge (3.1 Miles)
